As part of the "In Christ Alone" sermon series, Pastor Estay explained how in Biblical time someone's debt was taking so seriously that debtors or debtor's children were often taken as slaves until that debt was paid. However, for God is serious business when creditors take advantage of debtors getting interests for their debts; this is why, God asked a year of remission every 7th year. Israelites failed in doing so, and as a consequence, they had to live in exiled in Babylonian captivity for 70 years. Debt in the New Testament has a spiritual perspective, as is shown in the parable of the two debtors, where the one who owed the king 10 thousand talents and its debt was forgiven, was unable to forgive his debtor of one hundred denarii. "What God has forgiven His people, said Pastor Estay, is beyond human calculation. Because God has forgiven you zillions, He only asks is for you to forgive people thousands."

Papers were distributed for member to write their name as a way to accept Jesus' forgiveness of our sins on the cross. Colossians 2:13-14 says, "you being dead in your trespasses and in uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us, He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross."

"You can walk debt free out of this church today," said Pastor. Many accepted this called, wrote their names, and nailed them in a cross that was placed in front.
